**INDUSTRY NOTIFICATION OF FORMAL OPENING OF THE CASA E-EXAM CENTRE,
PORT MORESBY 2016.**

The Civil Aviation Safety Authority of Papua New Guinea wishes to notify Industry that in partnership with ASPEQ (formerly known as ASL, NZ) CASA PNG is launching the Port Moresby, PNG electronic-exam centre, with the first e-exam sitting for Aircraft Maintenance Engineer licensing exams scheduled for **Tuesday 23rd February, 2016 at CASA PNG HQ Building 3, Morea Tobo Rd, Six Mile, Port Moresby, PNG.**

This notification is to allow candidates **14 days** from today, to log on and register themselves to sit preferred e-exams session(s) online via the Booking Portal which can be accessed directly on the following URL: <https://casapng.aspegexams.com>. The first available exam session starts on **Tuesday 23rd February, 2016.**

The above initiative has been implemented in response to both ICAO and Industry expectation of independence, accountability and transparency in the CASA PNG Personnel Licensing examination processes.

We are commencing initially with the Aircraft Maintenance Engineer Licensing technical exams including PNG AME-Air Law exams, however, we will be extending this capability to include flight crew licensing exams (including Air Law) and ATC licensing exams (including Air Law) within 6 months.

We are also working closely with CASA Australia, CAA New Zealand and other regional CAAs that will enable candidates in Papua New Guinea to have access to their foreign licensing exams via the Port Moresby, e-exam center in due course.
