STATUTORY INSTRUMENT.

Civil Aviation (Personnel) (Offences) Regulation 2022.

Being a Regulation to provide for offences and penalties pursuant to Section 322 of the *Civil Aviation Act* 2000 in relation to Civil Aviation Rule Part 61, 63, 65, 66, 67 and 183, and for related purposes,

MADE by the Head of State, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council under the *Civil Aviation Act* 2000.

PART I. - CIVIL AVIATION RULE PART 61 - PILOT LICENCES AND RATINGS.

Division 1. - General.

- 1. REQUIREMENT FOR PILOT LICENCE AND RATINGS, ETC. (RULE PART 61.5).
 - (1) A person who -
 - (a) operates an aircraft; or
- (b) allows another person to operate an aircraft, within or outside Papua New Guinea without the requisite licence as prescribed in Rule Part 61.5(a), (b) or (c) is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00, and for a company, a fine of K10,000.00.

- (2) A person who -
 - (a) operates an aircraft; or
- (b) allows another person to operate an aircraft, within or outside Papua New Guinea without the requisite current aircraft type rating for that aircraft as prescribed in Rule Part 61.5(d) is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00, and for a company, a fine of K10,000.00.

(3) A person who -

(a) operates an aircraft; or

(b) allows another person to operate an aircraft, operating under IFR, without the requisite current instrument rating as prescribed in Rule Part 61.5(e) is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:]

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00, and for a company, a fine of K10,000.00.

(4) A person who exercises privileges of a flight instructor without the requisite current flight instructor rating as prescribed in Rule Part 61.5(f) is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00

(5) A person who exercises privileges of a flight examiner without the requisite current flight examiner rating as prescribed in Rule Part 61.5(g) is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00

2. VALIDATION PERMIT FOR A FOREIGN PILOT LICENCE (RULE PART 61.9).

A person who applies for a validation permit without the requisite documentation or gives false or misleading information on matters prescribed by Rule Part 61.9(a) is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00, and for a company, a fine of K10,000.00.

3. ACCEPTANCE OF FOREIGN LICENCES (RULE PART 61.13).

A person who applies for acceptance of a foreign licence without the requisite documentation or gives false or misleading information on matters prescribed by Rule Part 61.13(c) is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

4. WRITTEN EXAMINATIONS - UNAUTHORISED CONDUCT (RULE PART 61.19).

A person who does any of the acts referred to in Rule Part 61.19(a), during a written examination, is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

5. FLIGHT TESTS (RULE PART 61.21).

A person who applies for a flight test without producing the documentation required under Rule Part 61.21(a) is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

6. FLIGHT TRAINING AND TESTING - GENERAL REQUIREMENTS (RULE PART 61.25).

A person who applies for a pilot licence or rating without complying with the requirements of Rule Part 61.25 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

7. STATUS OF FLIGHT EXAMINERS (RULE PART 61.27).

A flight examiner who fails to comply with the requirements of Rule Part 61.27 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

8. PILOT LOGBOOKS - GENERAL REQUIREMENTS (RULE PART 61.29).

A student pilot and the holder of a pilot licence who fail to comply with the requirements of Rule Part 61.29 are guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

9. PILOT LOGBOOKS - CREDITING FLIGHT TIME (RULE PART 61.31).

A pilot, flight instructor or flight examiner who makes false entries into a logbook to gain flight time credit under Rule Part 61.31 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

10 PILOT LOGBOOKS - CREDITING GROUND TIME (RULE PART 61.33).

An instructor who falsely certifies the time in the pilot's logbook under Rule Part 61.33 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

11 MEDICAL REQUIREMENT (RULE PART 61.35).

A person with -

(a) a pilot licence; or

(b) a validation permit for a foreign pilot licence, who exercises privileges without fulfilling the requirements of Rule Part 61.35 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

12. RECENT FLIGHT EXPERIENCE - PILOT IN COMMAND AND CO-PILOT (RULE PART 61.37).

(1) An airline transport pilot who does not comply with the requirements of Rule Part 61.37(a) is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

(2) A day flight commercial pilot, or day flight private pilot who does not comply with the requirements of Rule Part 61.37(b) is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

(3) A night flight air transport pilot, a night flight commercial pilot, or a night flight private pilot who does not comply with the requirements of Rule Part 61.37(c) is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

(4) A helicopter pilot who does not comply with the requirements of Rule Part 61.37(d) is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

(5) A flight instructor who does not comply with the requirements of Rule Part 61.37(f) is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

(6) An airline operator who allows its agents and servants to breach the requirements of Subsections (1) to (5), inclusive, in guilty of an offence.

Penalty: For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00, and for a company, a fine of K10,000.00

13. BIENNIAL FLIGHT REVIEW (RULE PART 61.39).

(1) A holder of a pilot licence who does not comply with the requirements of Rule Part 61.39(a) is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

(2) A flight instructor who does not comply with the requirements of Rule Part 61.39(d) is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

14. USE OF LOWER PILOT LICENCE OR RATING (RULE PART 61.41).

A holder of a pilot licence who does not comply with the requirements of Rule Part 61.41 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

15. EXAMINATION FOR PROFICIENCY (RULE PART 61.43).

A holder of a pilot licence or rating that is issued under this part who does not comply with the requirements of Rule Part 61.43 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

16. OFFENCES INVOLVING SUBSTANCES OF ABUSE (RULE PART 61.45).

A holder of a pilot licence or rating who is convicted for drug or alcohol abuse is guilty of an offence under this part.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

Division 2. - Aircraft Type Ratings.

17. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT (RULE PART 61.53).

A person who operates an aircraft without satisfying the requirements of Rule Part 61.53 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00, and for a company, a fine of K10,000.00.

18. ISSUE (RULE PART 61.55).

A flight instructor who does not comply with the requirements of Rule Part 61.55 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00, and for a company, a fine of K10,000.00.

19. FIRST OF TYPE AUTHORISATION (RULE PART 61.57).

A holder of a current flight instructor rating who acts as a pilot or pilot-in-command without the authorisation of the Director under Rule Part 61.57 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00, and for a company, a fine of K10,000.00.

Division 3. - Aircraft Class Ratings.

20. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT (RULE PART 61.73).

A person who operates an aircraft without satisfying the requirements of Rule Part 61.73 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

Division 4. - Student Pilots.

21. GENERAL (RULE PART 61.103).

A person who operates an aircraft without satisfying the requirements of Rule Part 61.103 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

22. SOLO FLIGHT REQUIREMENTS (RULE PART 61.105).

(1) A person who flies an aircraft solo without satisfying the requirements of Rule Part 61.105 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

(2) A flight instructor who authorise or oversee a solo flight without complying with the requirements of Rule Part 61.105 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

23. LIMITATIONS (RULE PART 61.107).

A person who acts a pilot -in-command an aircraft in contravention of Rule Part 61.107 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

Division 5. - Private Pilot Licences.

24. PRIVILEGES AND LIMITATIONS (RULE PART 61.155).

A holder of a current private pilot licence who acts as a pilot -in-command or a copilot of an aircraft, in contravention of Rule Part 61.155, is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

25. CURRENCY REQUIREMENTS (RULE PART 61.157).

A holder of a current private pilot licence who does not comply with the requirements of Rule Part 61.157 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K.5,000.00.

Division 6. - Commercial Pilot Licences.

26. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS (RULE PART 61.203).

A person who acts as a commercial pilot without fulfilling the requirements of Rule Part 61.203 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

27. PRIVILEGES AND LIMITATIONS (RULE PART 61.205).

A holder of a current commercial pilot licence who acts as a pilot -in-command or a co-pilot of an aircraft, in contravention of Rule Part 61.205, is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

28. CURRENCY REQUIREMENTS (RULE PART 61.207).

A holder of a current commercial pilot licence who does not comply with the requirements of Rule Part 61.207 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

Division 7. - Airline Transport Pilot Licences.

29. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS (RULE PART 61.253).

A person who acts as an airline transport pilot without fulfilling the requirements of Rule Part 61.253 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

30. PRIVILEGES (RULE PART 61.255).

A holder of a current airline transport pilot licence who exercises the privileges under Rule Part 61.255, in contravention of Rule Part 61.255, is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

Division 8. - Flight Instructor Ratings.

31. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS (RULE PART 61.303).

A person who acts as a flight instructor in the categories described in Rule Part 61.303, without fulfilling the requirements of Rule Part 61.303, is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

32. ISSUE (RULE PART 61.304).

A flight instructor who does not comply with the requirements of Rule Part 61.304 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

33. PRIVILEGES AND LIMITATIONS (RULE PART 61.305).

A person who acts as a flight instructor in the categories described in Rule Part 61.305, without fulfilling the requirements of Rule Part 61.303, is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

34. CURRENCY REQUIREMENTS (RULE PART 61.307).

A person who acts as a flight instructor in the categories described in Rule Part 61.305, without complying with the requirements of Rule Part 61.307, is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

Division 9. - Flight Operations Officer/Flight Dispatcher.

35. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS (RULE PART 61.403).

A person who acts as a flight operations officer or flight dispatcher, without fulfilling the requirements of Rule Part 61.403, is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

Division 10. - Agricultural Ratings.

36. ISSUE (RULE PART 61.703).

A flight instructor or flight examiner who does not comply with the requirements of Rule Part 61.703 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

37. PRIVILEGES AND LIMITATIONS (RULE PART 61.705).

A person who acts as a pilot on an agricultural aircraft operation without complying with the requirements of Rule Part 61.705, is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

38. CURRENCY REQUIREMENTS (RULE PART 61.707).

A person who acts as a pilot on an agricultural aircraft operation without complying with the requirements of Rule Part 61.707, is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

Division 11. - Pilot Chemical Rating.

39. ISSUE (RULE PART 61.753).

The person who completed the assessment required by Rule Part 61.751 and issues a false or misleading rating in the pilot's logbook under Rule Part 61.753 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

40. PRIVILEGES (RULE PART 61.755).

A pilot who dispenses an agricultural chemical from an aircraft on an agricultural aircraft operation in contravention of Rule Part 61.755 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

41. CURRENCY REQUIREMENTS (RULE PART 61.757).

A holder of a pilot chemical rating who exercises the privileges in contravention of Rule Part 61.757 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

Division 12. - Instrument Ratings.

42. ISSUE (RULE PART 61.803).

A person who gives false or misleading statements to the Director, in an application for an instrument rating under Rule Part 61.801, is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K5,000.00.

43. PRIVILEGES AND LIMITATIONS (RULE PART 61.805).

A person who provides a false or misleading medical report under Rule Part 67.71 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

A person who issues a medical report in contravention of Rule Part 67.73 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K3,000.00.

113. MEDICAL CONFIDENTIALITY (RULE PART 67.81).

A person who breach medical confidentiality under Rule Part 67.81 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

Division 2. - Designated Aviation Medical Examiners.

A person applying to become a designated aviation medical examiner without complying with the requirements of Rule Part 67.155 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

A designated aviation medical examiner who fails to comply with the requirements of Rule Part 67.157 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K3,000.00.

116. EXPOSITION (RULE PART 67.161).

A designated aviation medical examiner who fails to comply with the requirements of Rule Part 67.161 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K3,000.00.

117. OBLIGATION TO REPORT (RULE PART 67.165).

A designated aviation medical examiner who fails to comply with the requirements of Rule Part 67.165 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K3,000.00.

118. INDEMNIFICATION OF MEDICAL REPORTING (RULE PART 67.167).

A person or organisation specified in Rule Part 67.167 who gives false or misleading statements regarding a person's medical condition is guilty of an offence.

Division 4. - Authorised Airworthiness Representatives.

125. DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED WITH APPLICATION (RULE PART 183.505).

A person who applies to become an authorised airworthiness representative under Rule Part 183.505 without fulfilling the requirements of Rule Part 183.309 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty:

For an individual, a fine of K3,000.00.

PART VII. - MISCELLANEOUS.

126. APPLICATION OF OTHER ACTS.

For the purposes of prosecution under this Regulation, the following provisions of the *Criminal Code Act* 1974 shall apply:

- (a) Section 7 of that Act relating to offences committed in prosecution of common purposes; and
- (b) Section 8 of that Act relating to offences committed in prosecution of common purposes; and
- (c) Section 9 of that Act relating to mode of execution immaterial; and
- (d) the provisions of Subsection 10(1) only, of that Act relating to accessories after the fact.

127. PRESERVATION OF RIGHTS AND LIABILITIES UNDER OTHER LAWS, ETC.

Except where the contrary intention appear, nothing in this Regulation takes away from any persons any defence, right or liability, whether civil or criminal that -

- (a) is or has been available, acquired or incurred: or
- (b) will or may be available, acquired or incurred, to or by him under any other law, but nothing in this section shall be deemed to show a contrary intention within the meaning of the *Interpretation Act* (Chapter 2) or to affect Section 16 of the Criminal Code, or any other similar law.

128. STANDARD OF PROOF.

The standard of proof to be applied in proceedings under this regulation shall be that applied in civil proceedings, namely, proof on the balance of probabilities.

129. INFRINGEMENT FINES.

The fines prescribed under this Regulation, shall be payable to the Authority.

130. ON-THE-SPOT INFRINGEMENT FINES.

- (1) Where it appears to a member of the Authority or a prescribed officer that a person has committed a prescribed offence against this Regulation, the member of the Authority or prescribed officer may serve on the person a notice in the prescribed form to the effect that if he does not desire to have the matter determined by a court he may pay to an officer specified in the notice, within the time specified in the notice, the amount of the penalty prescribed for the offence if dealt with under this section.
 - (2) A notice under Subsection (1) may be served -
 - (a) personally; or
 - (b) by post; or
 - (c) by electronic means; or
 - (d) by leaving it on or in the premises of the person.
- (3) It is sufficient for the notice to be addressed in a letter format, containing the charge and the facts on which an offence has been committed and the appropriate fine.
- (4) A person alleged to have committed an offence to which Subsection (1) applies has the right to decline to be dealt with under this section.
- (5) For the purposes of Subsection (3), a person who fails to pay, within the time specified in the notice or such further time as is allowed in any particular case, the penalty to which a notice under Subsection (1) relates shall be deemed to have declined to be dealt with under this section.
- (6) Where the amount of the prescribed penalty for an alleged offence is paid in accordance with this section, no person is liable to any further proceedings for the offence.
- (7) Payment, in accordance with this section, of a penalty in respect of an alleged offence -
 - (a) shall not be regarded as an admission of liability for the purposes of this Regulation; and
- (b) does not affect or prejudice, any criminal proceedings, other than proceedings for the alleged offence or any civil claim, action or proceeding arising out of the same occurrence.
- (8) A penalty prescribed for the purposes of this section for a prescribed offence shall not exceed the maximum amount of penalty that could be imposed for the offence by a court.
- (9) Subject to Subsection (5) and (6), this section is supplementary to, and not in derogation of, any other provision of the Act, this Regulation or any other law in relation to proceedings that may be taken in respect of prescribed offences.

(10) Notwithstanding the Constitutional provisions relating to the imposition of a fine without a Court hearing, it is in the National interest for the benefit of public safety for an 'On The Spot' infringement fine to be imposed as a form of penalty according to the offender's desire.

131. POWERS OF ARREST.

- (1) Notwithstanding any other law but subject to the provisions of the Arrest Act (Chapter 339), this section applies to and in relation to an arrest for an offence made by or under this Regulation.
- A policeman, an authorised office or agent of the Authority may, without warrant, arrest a person whom they believe on reasonable grounds:
 - (a) is committing; or
- (b) has committed an offence, under this Regulation.
- (3) For the purposes of this section a "policeman" means a member of the Police Force and includes Reserve Constabulary.
