

Civil Aviation Safety Authority International Civil Aviation Organization Asia Pacific Safety Management Seminar and CASA Australia Led workshop

The Civil Aviation Authority of Papua New Guinea (CASA PNG) had the pleasure of participating in the ICAO Asia Pacific Safety Management seminar and a CASA Australia led workshop held at the ICAO Regional Headquarters, Bangkok, Hanoi Thailand from 03rd to 06th February 2025. The conference was attended by our Meteorology Inspector Mr Konny Nato, Airworthiness inspector Ms Theresa Efi, Safety Trend Analysis Officer Ms Lydia Evesa and Flight Operations Inspector Miss Selina Kule.

The Seminar provided a community forum for safety management professionals across the spectrum of industry in the APAC regions. Civil Aviation Authorities (CAAs), Air Navigation Service Providers

(ANSPs) and industry will gather to foster safety partnership and build a stronger and more resilient network of safety practitioners to support the industry's continuing efforts to maintain or improve safety performance.

The CASA-AUS Australia led workshop commenced on the 06th Feb 2025 between Australia, Indonesia & PNG and was focused on the challenges and lessons learned in



enhancing the Safety Management Systems (SMS), State Safety Program (SSP), and National Aviation Safety Plan (NASP). It featured a collaborative sharing of experiences from each State, with a focus on safety performance monitoring and the lessons learned along the way. The session addressed four key areas drawn from Australia's journey in developing their SSP and their second NASP.
